


KEY RESULTS

- Many respondents say their companies have adopted agentic AI but finding it hard to transition from pilot programs to broader implementation due to the complexity of the technology. This could imply that most agentic AI projects are early-stage experiments or proofs-of-concept driven by hype, and their organization's legacy systems can't easily accommodate these autonomous agents without substantial reengineering.
- Their companies are using agentic AI in high-impact areas like IT, marketing, and operations for performing decision-making tasks, complex workflow automation, and improve enterprise productivity. This suggests more success stories will only emerge from firms willing to rethink workflows from the ground up.
- Respondents reported that their organizations have tapped into both the established technology giants and innovative startups for developing and deploying their agentic AI solutions. With agentic AI market is experiencing substantial growth, it's important for organizations partner with vendors to address challenges related to performance, cost, trust, and governance for the widespread and successful adoption of this transformative technology.


Two-thirds say their organizations currently have active agentic AI projects

Q: How many agentic AI projects (including pilots and fully deployed ones) are currently active across your organization?




Most agentic AI projects don't become fully implemented

Q: Approximately what percentage of your organization's agentic AI pilot projects become fully implemented?




This is mainly due to integration complexity and organizational readiness

Q: Which of the following business units or departments in your organization are currently leveraging AI agents (either as a pilot project or already in production)?




Their organizations' first AI agents were designed for elevating routine task automation and knowledge work

Q: What purpose was your organization's first AI agent designed for?




They mostly use key tech enterprise players like Google and Microsoft to develop and deploy AI agents.

Q: What type of company provides your organization with AI agents?




Many of their organizations already have an existing business relationship with the vendors providing their AI agents
